

A MESSAGE FROM THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER

We've had another week of only a few reported cases of COVID-19 in Medina County—a trend we hope is here to stay as we continue into the summer months.

This plateau in COVID-19 cases is encouraging, but it's also sparked some questions on the prevalence of the virus in our community. As your Health Department, part of our job is to provide accurate and timely information that you can use to make decisions that are best for you, your family, and your neighbors.

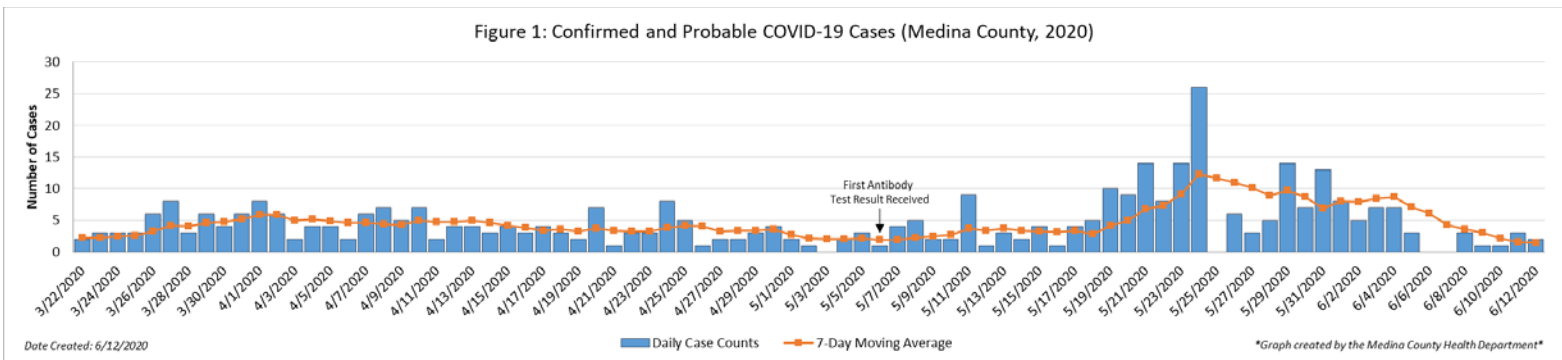


A couple of weeks ago, we launched a new dashboard on our website to provide visibility into where the virus is and who it's currently affecting. We hope having this data available helps to address some of those questions and gives you insights into how the virus is moving through Medina.

Another resource we've had the opportunity to make available is COVID-19 testing for the general public. We are now testing both symptomatic and asymptomatic individuals of any age. We are holding a by appointment drive-thru testing day on Thursday, June 18 at Brunswick High School from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. If you are sick or think you may have come into contact with someone who is sick, call our Health Center at 330-723-9688, option 1 to register for a no cost test. Future dates and locations are being planned so that testing is available and convenient for those who need it.

7-Day Moving Average Graph with Total Daily Case Counts

Below is our most up-to-date 7-day trend graph. This graph shows the daily confirmed and probable cases (blue bars) and the 7-day moving average (orange line) for new cases per day. The 7-day moving average helps show short-term increases and long-term trends in the number of cases. This graph and other data are located on our website and will be updated every Friday.
