

Our mission is to prevent disease, assure a healthful environment, prolong life, and promote well-being for the citizens of Medina County.

1. A 10-year renewal of existing .70 mill levy, with the addition of .15 mill
2. Cost to home owners will be **\$14.70 per year on \$100,000 of valuation** (of which \$5.24 is the additional mill)
3. The Health Department obtains non-levy funding for much of its operations, and **69% of expenses are paid from non-levy sources**
4. This levy was renewed at .70 mill in 2002 and 2012
5. Services are provided to residents of **all cities, townships, and villages** in Medina County
6. Your Health Department is **Nationally Accredited**, and this enables us to obtain additional, non-levy funding
