**Important Changes to Medina County Health Department 2<sup>nd</sup> Dose  
COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Tomorrow**

**MEDINA, OHIO, February 19, 2021** – Medina County Health Department received notification that a scheduled shipment of COVID-19 vaccine has been delayed due to inclement weather. **Medina County Health Department's second dose COVID-19 vaccine clinic scheduled for tomorrow, February 20, 2021 has been modified.**

Based on vaccine delivered, some residents scheduled for the February 20 second dose clinic will be asked to reschedule. We are working on details to reschedule citizens within the CDC's timeframe. Individuals with appointments will be notified. There is no need to call the Health Department.

Second dose clinics planned next week are pending. While we anticipate shipments arriving at the beginning of the week, our ability to schedule clinics is based on vaccine received. Citizens with appointments will be notified.
