C.E.R.T.-TI-NI



Ingredients:

- Orange juice
- Ginger ale
- Orange slices
- Maraschino cherries

- Mix 1/2 cup ginger ale and 1/2 cup orange juice
- Add 1/4 orange slice to side of martini glass
- Place maraschino cherry on a toothpick and lay over glass as a garnish





- Hawaiian Punch-Berry Blue Typhoon
- Zero Sugar Twist Up-Lemon Lime Soda
- Rose's blueberry syrup
- Whip cream (optional)
- Sprinkles (optional)

- Mix 1 gallon of Hawaiian Punch,
 (2) 2 Liters of Twist up, and 12oz of Blueberry Syrup
- Top with one spray of whip cream and a dash of sprinkles (optional)



- Sprite
- Fanta
- Cream soda
- Grenadine
- Whip cream (optional)

- Mix 1/4 container fanta, 1/2 can sprite, 1/4 can cream soda, and grenadine syrup
- Add whip cream garnish on top (optional)



- 2 cups grape juice
- 1 cup water
- 1 cup pomegranate juice
- 1/2 cup cranberry juice
- 1-2 tsp maple syrup (to taste)
- 2 cinnamon sticks
- 6 whole cloves
- 3 star anise
- 1 orange, sliced

- Add all ingredients except orange slices to large pot over medium heat. Simmer for 20-30 minutes.
- Add orange slices just prior to serving.
- Strain into cups and garnish as desired. 6





- Hot chocolate
- Water
- Marshmallows
- Whip cream
- Candy canes

- Mix hot water, hot chocolate together
- Add marshmallows, whipped cream, and candy canes (optional)





- Lemon juice
- Lime juice
- Pineapple
- Grapes
- Strawberries
- Maraschino cherries
- Oranges
- Hawaiian Punch
- 7up

- Cut and add all fruit to a bowl
- Spray with lemon and lime juice
- Add Hawaiian Punch
- Spray with lemon and lime juice again
- Shake and let sit overnight
- Add 7up one day later

SLEIGHBALL SELTZER



Ingredients:

- 1 oz. monin black rasberry syrup
- 7 oz. club soda
- ice
- Garnish: blackberries and mint leaves (optional)

- Fill serving glass with ice
- Add 1 oz. black rasberry syrup, 7 oz. club soda
- Stir well or transfer from serving glass to preferred glass
- Garnish with blackberries and mint leaves



Cleveland Clinic

Ingredients:

- 2 cups cranberry juice
- 1 cup orange juice
- 1 cup pineapple juice
- 2 cups apple juice
- 1 cup ginger ale
- Orange slice for garnish

Directions:

• Add all ingredients to a pitcher and mix together

MUG SHOT



Ingredients:

- 2 oz. sparkling white grape juice
- 2 oz. sparkling blood orange water


Directions:

• Mix ingredients together



- Apple cider
- Ginger ale
- Lemon juice
- Cinnamon
- Sugar
- Brown sugar

- Combine equal parts ginger ale and apple cider
- add one tablespoon lemon juice per cup
- sprinkle cinnamon sugar over the top



- 1/4 cup NA blue curacao syrup
- 2 Tbsp. freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 3/4 cup pineapple juice
- 12 oz. lemon lime soda
- Colored sugar (for rimming)
- Additional lemon juice (for rimming)

- Mix the blue curacao syrup, lemon juice, and pineapple juice in a 24 oz. container.
- Slowly mix in soda. Stir gently
- Rim glasses by dipping glass in lemon juice and then in sugar



- 1/2 Lime
- 2.5 oz. apple cider (or apple juice)
- 1 Tbs. apple butter
- 1 can ginger beer

- Freshly squeeze lime in a glass
- Add apple butter and apply cider
- Top with ginger beer



Grangetheory®

Ingredients:

- Cranberry juice
- Orange juice
- Ginger ale
- Lime juice
- Cinnamon sticks
- Orange slices
- Cranberries

- Pour equal parts cranberry juice and orange juice into a glass
- Add 2 Tbsp. of lime juice and a splash of ginger ale on top
- Garnish with an orange slice, cinnamon stick, and cranberry



- 2 liters of ginger ale
- 1 large bottle of cranberry juice
- 1 half gallon of raspberry sherbet
- Edible glitter sugar

- Mix ginger ale and cranberry juice
- Use ice cream scooper to scoop balls of raspberry sherbet into punch bowl
- Add a pinch of edible sugar in glass before serving
- Freeze cranberries in ice cubes and place in glass before serving (optional)

Best Taste 2022

Ingredients:

- 2 oz. white-cran peach
- 1 oz. zero sugar minute made lemonade
- 1 oz. minute made berry punch
- 1 oz. raspberry sparkling water
- Cotton candy

- Combine white cran-peach juice, lemonade and berry punch
- Place a piece of cotton candy over the cup and then pour the raspberry sparkling water over the cotton candy and let it dissolve



ВСРААА

- 60 oz. fresh ripe pineapple
- 60 oz. cucumber (seeded or seedless), peeled and coarsely chopped
- 120 oz. fresh mint leaves (4 small bunches)
- 90 fresh cilantro leaves (1 large bunch)
- 4 Tbs. lime-chile salt (Tajin)
- 6 Tbs. agave nectar
- 1.5 cup fresh lime juice, or more as needed
- 12 oz. serrano pepper, stemmed, seeded and chopped

- Combine the pineapple, cucumber, mint, cilantro (to taste). chile-lime salt, agave nectar and lime juice in a blender; puree until smooth
- Add the chopped serrano pepper by the teaspoon, blending and tasting after each addition to assess the spice level
- Once the heat is to your liking, adjust the salt, lime and sweetness
- Puree again briefly, then strain through a fine-mesh strainer, discarding the solids
- Chill until serving (*the yield is about 2 1/2 cups)





ВСРААА

- 45 oz. tomato juice
- 36 oz. grapefruit juice, freshly squeezed
- 36 oz. orange juice, freshly squeezed
- 12 oz. lime juice, freshly squeezed
- 5 oz. tabasco
- 4 Tbs. black pepper, freshly ground
- 2 Tbs. salt
- 6 jalapeno peppers, halved (with seeds)
- 1/2 lb. red seedless grapes
- 1 cup pineapple juice from can + squeezed pineapple slices
- 1/2 cup sugar

- Add the tomato juice, grapefruit juice, orange juice, lime juice, tabasco, black pepper, salt, and jalapeno pepper into a pitcher and stir until the salt dissolves
- Let stand for 15 to 30 minutes, then remove and discard the jalapeno (the longer the jalapeno infuses, the spicier the Sangrita will be)
- Add grapes, pineapple juice and sugar



ACC

Ingredients:

- Sunkiss Berry Lemonade
- Ocean Spray White Cran-Peach
- NA blue curacao syrup
- Blue edible drink glitter
- Blueberries

Directions:

• Combine all ingredients





- Sprite
- Orange juice
- Grenadine
- Orange slices (garnish)
- Maraschino cherries (garnish)

- Combine the sprite, orange juice, and grenadine
- Garnish the glass with an orange slice and maraschino cherry (optional)



- 12 oz. can frozen lemonade concentrate
- 2 litres of sprite
- 1 tub of pineapple sherbet
- 4 cans warm water (use lemonade can)
- 1-2 packets of raspberry lemonade kool-aid mix

- In a punch bowl, mix frozen lemonade with warm water
- Add Kool-aid and stir until dissolved
- Add Sprite and stir
- Add a scoop of pineapple sherbet to each cup and pour punch over the sherbet
