When Should I Stay Home?



I have a fever



Temperature of 100°F or higher

Ok to return to normal activities after being fever free without medication for 24 hours

I am vomiting



Within the past 24 hours

Ok to return to normal activities after being free from vomiting for 24 hours

I have diarrhea



Within the past 24 hours

Ok to return to normal activities after being free from diarrhea for 24 hours

I have a rash



Body rash with oozing, drainage or fever

Ok to return to normal activities after being free from rash or fever & have been seen by a medical provider if needed

I have a cough



Within the past 24 hours

Ok to return to normal activities after being seen by a medical provider if needed

I have an eye infection



Within the past 24 hours

Ok to return to normal activities after being free from drainage and/or have been seen by a medical provider if needed

I have been to the hospital



Within the past 24 hours

Ok to return to normal activities after being released by medical provider

If you have strep throat or a bacterial infection, you should stay home until the antibiotic has been given for at least 12-24 hours or your health care provider has approved your return to normal activities. Seek medical attention if you are sick and follow your healthcare provider's recommendations.
